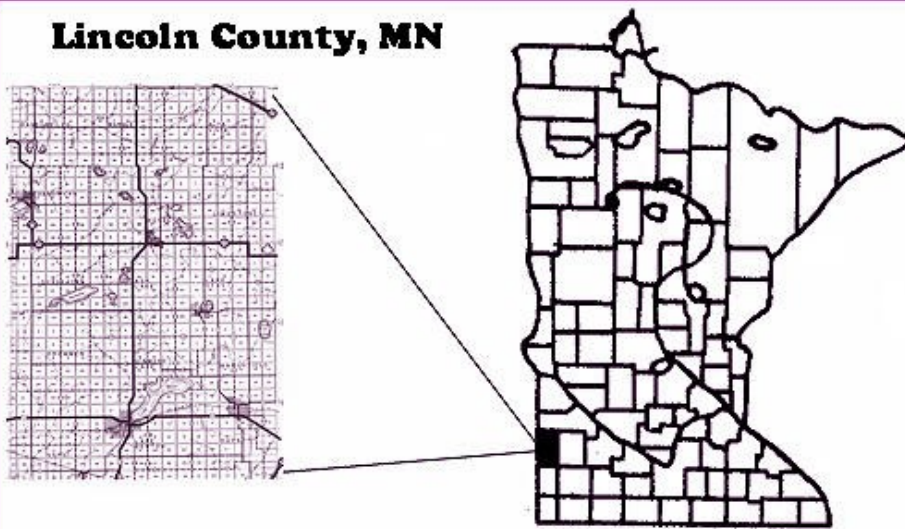

Overall Project Description:

State Cost Share Program was established in 1977 and is administered locally by the Lincoln Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD). The State Cost Share Program provides financial assistance to landowners for installing conservation practices that protect and improve water quality by controlling soil erosion and reducing sedimentation. TAA for State C-S Projects: Sterzinger as the Technician for all tree projects, Kraus as the Technician on all Nutrient Management and Nitrogen Stabilizer practices, and Ron Madsen as the Technician on all other practices unless otherwise stated in minutes and the cost-share rate is set at a rate not to exceed 75% of the total eligible costs of a practice. The SWCD provided technical assistance to landowners to install conservation practices by:

- Conducting a site investigation with the landowner;
- Working with the landowner to determine the best management practice (BMP) for the given situation;
- Surveying and designing the project;
- Producing a rough cost estimate and assisting with appropriate cost-share if applicable;
- Providing the landowner with a designed plan for submission of bids;
- Performing a pre-construction conference with the contractor and landowner;
- Supervising construction; and certifying completion of the project.
